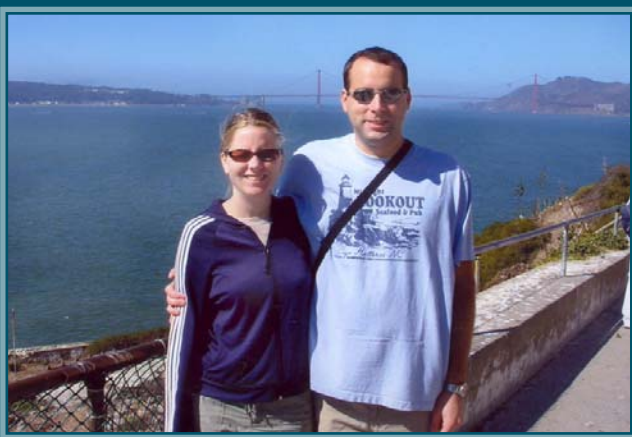


Traveling in Europe
